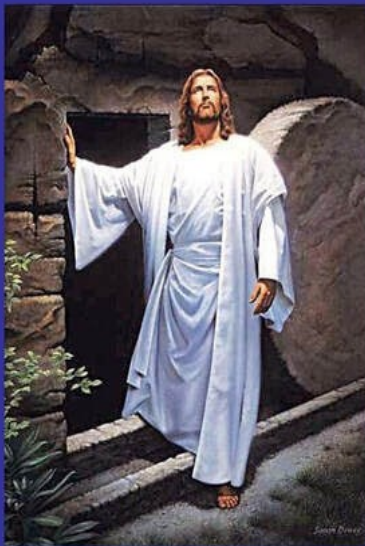

**Gospel Reflections:** As the disciples see Jesus and recognize his identity, their fear gives way to joy. This transformation is not just emotional but spiritual and existential. They are not just happy to see him; they are filled with the joy of knowing that death has been conquered, that Jesus is indeed the promised Messiah, that their faith is not in vain, and that the Divine Mercy of God is manifested in the personal encounter between Jesus and Thomas. Jesus repeats his greeting of peace and commissions the Apostles to carry his message to the world. Today we are invited to reflect on the Mercy of God and the transformative power of encountering the risen Christ, and the call to be sent as His witnesses. He tells them, "Receive the Holy Spirit." It is the Holy Spirit who equips and encourages us for our mission. Of course, like Thomas, we too can be victims of doubt in our faith journey, but Jesus challenges us to believe without seeing. Today how can we embrace and deepen our faith in the resurrected Lord?

### **Love of God Increases Our Desire for God**

When you love God and rejoice in that love, your desire for God will increase. The more you know Him, the more you will want to know Him, and the more you want to know Him, the more you will know Him.
